THE STOMP ROLL RUBBER FLOORING

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING MATERIALS

- Shop vac with soft bristle
- Soft nylon brush, microfiber mop, or 3M 5100 Red Pad
- Soap & water or mild detergent
- · Stiff decking brush, car washing brush, 3M 7100 Brown Pad, or 3M 7200 Black Pad (heavy duty cleaning only)



• Do not clean rubber flooring with any kind of solvent. Paint thinners or other "hot" products will eat at the binder and damage the rubber flooring.

INITIAL CLEANING PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove all surface soil, debris, sand, and grit by sweeping, dust mopping, or vacuuming.
- 2. Clean floor with soap & water using a rectangular microfiber mop. A soft nylon brush may be used in heavily soiled areas.
- 3. DO NOT flood the floor with water, as water can pass through any seams.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE CLEANING

- 1. Remove all surface soil, debris, sand, and grit by sweeping, dust mopping, or vacuuming.
- 2. Clean floor with soap & water using a rectangular microfiber mop. A soft nylon brush may be used in heavily soiled areas.

HEAVY DUTY CLEANING

- 1. Remove loose soil, debris, sand, and grit by sweeping or vacuuming
- 2. Scrub affected areas using a stiff decking brush or car washing brush and soap & water. Alternatively, a rotary scrubber or automatic scrubber can be used with a 3M 7100 Brown Pad or 3M 7200 Black Pad.
- 3. Rinse with clean water. Do not flood the floor.
- 4. Allow floor to thoroughly dry.
